## Diversified Business Model

Passenger Service: unique low-cost airline with focus on leisure travel

Charter: leading provider of narrowbody charter

Cargo: uses Sun Country pilots to fly both cargo and passenger service

## Notable Partnerships

- August 2018 – Sun Country enters into a travel partnership with Make-A-Wish Minnesota to provide flights for children with critical illnesses and hardships
- December 2019 - Sun Country partners with Amazon to expand cargo flying
- September 2021 - Caribou Coffee becomes the Official Coffee of Sun Country Airlines
- October 2021 – Sun Country signs five-year agreement to provide charter service to all Major League Soccer (MLS) teams
- November 2021 - Sun Country signs new five-year charter agreement with Caesars Entertainment, Inc. The original partnership was formed in August 2014
- January 2022 – Sun Country becomes the Official Airline of the Minnesota United Football Club (MNUFC)
- July 2022 – Sun Country becomes the Official Airline of Medtronic Twin Cities Marathon Weekend
