Diversified Business Model

We operate three successful lines of business - scheduled passenger service focused on leisure travel, cargo operations and charter flying. All three utilize shared resources like pilots and our fleet of Boeing 737-800 aircraft.

Notable Partnerships

- **August 2018** - Sun Country enters into a travel partnership with Make-A-Wish Minnesota to provide flights for children with critical illnesses and hardships
- **December 2019** - Sun Country partners with Amazon to expand cargo flying
- **September 2021** - Caribou Coffee becomes the Official Coffee of Sun Country Airlines
- **October 2021** - Sun Country signs five-year agreement to provide charter service to all Major League Soccer (MLS) teams
- **November 2021** - Sun Country signs new five-year charter agreement with Caesars Entertainment, Inc. The original partnership was formed in August 2014
- **January 2022** - Sun Country becomes the Official Airline of the Minnesota United Football Club (MNUFC)
- **January 2023** - Sun Country becomes the Official Airline of Twin Cities In Motion and Twin Cities Marathon Weekend
- **July 2023** - Sun Country becomes the Official Airline of Minnesota Gopher Athletics
